- 5. Divide the class into two teams.
- 6. Each team will take a turn selecting a balloon, popping it, and reading the question. If they can answer the question correctly, they are awarded a point. (If you choose, you may assign a different value to each question.)
- 7. If the team cannot answer the question correctly, the other team will have a chance to answer the question and be awarded the points.
- 8. Someone will keep score of the points awarded to each team.
- 9. After all the questions have been answered, the team with the most points wins!
